## BRIEF DESCRIPTIVE BIO

K Unnikrishnan Nair is currently Professor of Organizational Behaviour at the Indian Institute of Management Kozhikode (IIMK), and former ICCR Rot ating Chair Professor of Indian Studies, Friedrich Schiller University Jena, Germany. Obtaining doctoral degree from IIM Ahmedabad (IIMA; with multiple *Best Dissertation Proposal* Awards), he began his academic career in the Behavioral Sciences Group at IIM Calcutta (IIMC), later moving to IIM Kozhikode (IIMK). A graduate Mechanical Engineer from Kerala University (First Rank-Gold Medal) and a National Talent Search Scholar (NCERT, New Delhi), he was selected for B.Tech. at Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Kharagpur, and had worked in front-line managerial positions in a reputed and large integrated steel plant prior to his doctoral studies.

Unnikrishnan's research on themes such as organizational learning, social enterprises, decision-making in ill-structured situations, and change management and postmodern trends has been published in refereed international journals such as *Journal of Research in Personality*, *Nonprofit Management and Leadership*, *Systems Research & Behavioral Science*, *Simulation & Gaming*, *Marketing Intelligence and Planning* and *IIMB Management Review*. His chapter on Cognitive Maps of Managers & Complex Problem Solving in the book Organizational Cognition: Computation and Interpretation (Eds. Z Shapira & T Land, NJ: Lawrence Erlbaum Associates) won the Best Research Paper Award of the *Association of Indian Management Schools* (AIMS) in 1998; and the paper titled: Learning about Learning Routines: Insights from the Indian Social Enterprise Sector, co-authored with Ms. Ankita Tandon won the [Emerald] Best Paper Award and Cash Prize of £500 at the 2nd Pan IIM World Management Conference, 5-8 Nov 2014, held at IIM Kozhikode. He has also been presenting refereed papers at the Annual Meetings of the US Academy of Management in Divisions such as Managerial and Organizational Cognition (MOC), Organization & Management Theory (OMT) and Management Consulting.

Enthusiastic about being a teacher, he has been teaching in the MBA, Executive MBA, Ph.D., and Executive Ph.D. programs with consistently good student feedback. Over the years, in addition to teaching regular course, he has also newly conceptualized, designed and taught Courses such as *Philosophy of Management* (Doctoral Level Core Course), *Leadership: Applied, Conceptual & Evolving* (LACE), and *Management Consulting: Profession & Practice* (MCPP) (MBA Electives).

Besides academics, Unnikrishnan has been active in institution building, other responsible roles and social work since his student days, being the School Captain, elected Chairperson of College Students' Council, NCC Cadet in school, National Service Scheme (NSS) Volunteer in college, and a reader for the blind during his doctoral days, among others. At IIM Kozhikode he served as: Chairperson of its flagship Post Graduate Programme (PGP, i.e. MBA) and Publications & Research Dissemination; founder Chairperson of Organizational Behaviour & Human Resource (OBHR) Area, and Management Development Programmes (MDP); and founder Co-Chairperson of India's (and perhaps Asia-Pacific's) first Interactive Distance Learning (IDL) Programme, alongside a variety of other involvements, committee chair/memberships and roles. He has also served two tenures on the Board of Governors (BOG) of IIMK as a Member.

Unnikrishnan has also organized/taught-in a number of Management/Executive & Faculty Development Programmes for organizations such as: (i) *Corporate*: ABN-AMRO, Asianet, BEL, Cochin Shipyard, ECIL, ER&DC, Firstsource, GMR, HUL, JK, Kochi Refineries, L&T, Malabar Gold, Mankind Pharma, Mathrubhumi, MRPL, Reliance, SAP Labs and SBT; (ii) *NGO/Co-operative*: Socio Economic Unit Foundation and Vegetable & Fruit Promotion Council; (iii) *Defence*: Indian Army & Indian Naval Academy; (iv). *Educational*: Vice-Chancellors of Indian Universities, Faculty of TN & Kerala Veterinary & Animal Sciences University, TEQUIP Principals/Directors, and (v). *Government*: Senior Officers of the Indian Administrative (IAS), Police (IPS) and Forest (IFS) Services, on themes such as Organizational Leadership, Learning & Transformation; Change Management and Conflict Resolution. Most significantly, he had the good privilege to conduct/facilitate (rather than to 'teach!') an intensive session for the entire *Council of Ministers, Govt. of Kerala*, on the theme of *Building a Culture of High Performance*. Among his Consulting assignments have been the organizational re-structuring of Kerala Tourism Department (of God's Own Country fame), and top management strategy formulation retreat/workshop for Cochin Shipyard Ltd.

Born at the place where *Kathakali* originated (Kottarakara) and working at the place that triggered that beginning (Kozhikode), Unnikrishnan has interest in Classical Themes-Domains, Institutions, the Pope & the Vatican, the British Monarchy, Kerala Temples, Parliaments such as of India, UK & USA, and the Indian Armed Forces, and occasionally follows National-Global Events & Sports closely. The decision to participate in the 2002 "Best B-Schools" ranking by *Business Today* (arguably seen as the best and most comprehensive b-schools survey in India in those days) was very consciously and carefully taken by the Faculty Council chaired by the then Director Prof. A. H. Kalro. The data form was hand-filled by me, sitting in Prof. Saji Gopinath's faculty room, and with good support and inputs from Prof. Kalro. AND, giving extreme joy (with humility) to the IIMK Community, we were ranked Fifth! The punchline in *Business Today*'s evaluation of IIMK is noteworthy: "The youngest among the IIMs, it survives on rented infrastructure. But innovative teaching methodology sees it through" (p. 56). The description for IIM Indore, IIMK's same age cousin for its 7th Rank read: "Another young IIM, it managed to rake up the highest average salary in what was otherwise a bad year for B-Schools." (p. 56). The subtle difference in the essence of these two descriptions for IIMK and IIMI also might be noted. The top 10 in this ranking were: IIMB (1), IIMC (2), IIML (3), NITIE (4), IIMK (5), MDI (6), IIMI (7), SJSOM-IITB (8), SP Jain (9) & IIFT (10). IIMA did not participate. [Source: Business Today. (2002). The Best B-Schools in India. August 4, pp. 45-87; & THE TOP TEN, p. 56.]. This ranking formed a significant milestone in the morale and further evolution of IIMK.
