Abstract:

How to study caste in organizing? While caste remains arguably one of the oldest ways of organising work and workers into hierarchical systems in one of the most efficient ways: by birth; it remains understudied and unacknowledged within the organizational theory for its non-Western context, non-stagnant form and complex socio-historical origins (Bapuji et al, 2024; Chrispal et al, 2021).
